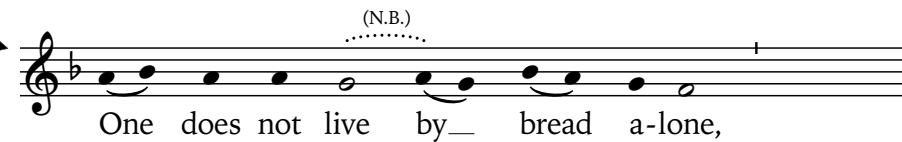

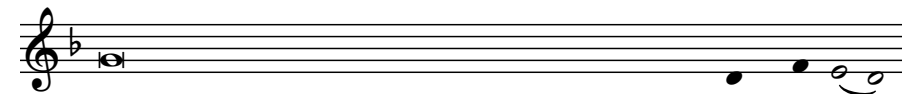

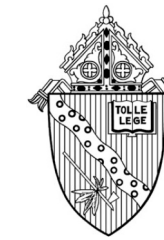
Recessional Hymn

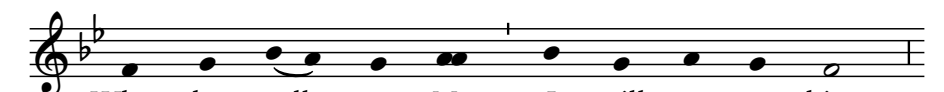
Processional Hymn

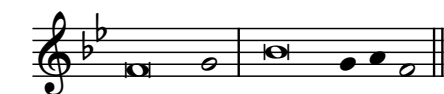
