Sung to the tune of Passion Chorale.


- 1. "A call that's made in earnest upon My holy Name shall be to Me sweet music, and I shall rescue them!



#### Mysterium Fidei


The Priest first intones: "Mysterium Fidei" (translated: "The mystery of Faith") to which **all** respond:
